## *Four-year intensive training emphasising an integrative and relational approach to counselling psychology and psychotherapy*

Training comprises a combination of on-site teaching and learning, delivered across 10 “long weekends” per year (Fri-Sun) between October and July, plus clinical and mental health familiarisation placements where candidates practice under supervision to continue their training and development. There is an emphasis on combining professional with personal development and candidates undertake personal therapy across all four years of clinical training.



The Metanoia Institute Doctorate in Counselling Psychology & Psychotherapy by Professional Studies is offered jointly with and is conferred by, Middlesex University. It is accredited by the British Psychological Society (BPS) as a training towards Chartered Psychologist status and approved by the Health and Care Professions Council (HCPC) as a training towards potential Registered Counselling Psychologist/Practitioner Psychologist status. Unlike many similar trainings, it is also accredited by the UK Council for Psychotherapy (UKCP) as a training towards registration as an Integrative Psychotherapist and eligibility to receive the European Certificate of Psychotherapy.

**All programme tutors are in clinical practice and active in ongoing research projects. Candidates are each assigned a personal tutor to support them through study. “The team are passionate about helping you achieve”**
